CERTIFICATION OF JARED WEINGARTNER

Jared Weingartner states and alleges as follows:

1. That I am the Supervisor – Williston & PRB Facilities of Continental Resources, Inc. (“Continental”), with authority to bind Continental to requirements set forth by the North Dakota Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) with respect to Continental’s 8-inch natural gas pipeline in Williams County, North Dakota (collectively, the “Project”), which is at issue in the above-captioned matter.
2. That I submit this certification in accordance with North Dakota Century Code § 49-22.1-15(3) in support of Continental’s route adjustment for the Project located outside the designated corridor.
3. That on July 6, 2022, the Commission issued its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order for the Project and Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 228 and Route Permit No. 238 designating the corridor and route for the Project.
4. That, at the request of Basin Electric Power Cooperative, Continental has adjusted a segment of the approved route in Township 156 North, Range 99 West, Section 35, due to the proximity of the approved route to an electric transmission tower.
5. The original corridor and route approved by the Commission and the route adjustment for the Project are depicted on the map attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

6. That the route adjustment and associated construction activities will not affect any known exclusion or avoidance areas.
7. That portion of the adjusted route located outside of the designated corridor is not longer than one and one-half (1.5) miles.
8. That Continental will comply with the Commission's orders, laws, and rules designating the corridor and the route.
9. That each owner of real property on which the adjustment is to be located and any applicable governmental entity with an interest in the same adjustment area do not oppose the adjustment.
10. That supplemental field studies and surveys were conducted on the area encompassing the route outside the designated corridor equal to the length of the adjustment of the proposed corridor. No exclusion or avoidance areas are located within the adjusted corridor.
