
Dear Mr. Renfandt:

I am writing on behalf of ONEOK Bakken Pipeline, L.L.C. ("ONEOK") in response to your request for ONEOK to clarify its prior response to your April 22, 2022 Request for Information No. 4 pertaining to maximum pipeline capacity. With the addition of the proposed Spring Creek II Pump Station, the total throughput of the Demicks Lake Pipeline is estimated at 300,000 barrels per day (bpd). Ultimately, future additional plants and connections could bring the total throughput of the Pipeline to the maximum design capacity of 400,000 bpd.

ONEOK is preparing a supplemental response that will provide additional details regarding the above-referenced capacity thresholds.
