
Dear Mr. Renfandt:

I am writing on behalf of ONEOK Bakken Pipeline, L.L.C. ("ONEOK") regarding Case No. PU-22-164. On June 29, 2022, the Commission issued an order granting First Amended Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 209 and First Amended Route Permit No. 219 to ONEOK for the addition of a pump station facility along the existing Demicks Lake Pipeline in McKenzie County, North Dakota. Certification Relating to Order Provision No. 33 states ONEOK shall provide an electronic and paper copy of the corridor approved by the Commission and the facility design specifications for the constructed project within three months of construction completion.

ONEOK has experienced a delay in receiving final as-built information from its contractor. As a result, ONEOK respectfully requests a 30-day extension until August 11, 2023, to file the information requested under Certification Provision No. 33.
