



10. I have reviewed the map on page 5 (PDF page) of HTC's One-Call complaint and believe the map to be an accurate depiction of the area that includes the Excavation Site. I have also reviewed the photos identified as photos #3, #4, and #5 on pages 9-11 (PDF pages) of HTC's complaint and believe the photos to depict the Excavation Site after ECI cut the cables.
11. I have reviewed the photos identified as #3 and #4 and believe the white vertical pipe depicted in the photos is the valve I would have marked for placement.
12. I recall that HTC's flags traveled parallel with my marked route for at least a mile South of the Excavation Site. I do not recall if the HTC cable jogged to the West at the Excavation Site. I do not recall if a utility flag conflicted with my marked route or the marked valve at the Excavation Site. .
13. The tall wood stake in the top left hand of photo #5 appears to be the type of marker I would have used to mark the water line route except for the yellow or gold colored top. Utilities usually use metal flags to mark the location of their underground utilities. The marker in photo #5, if mine, does not appear to be in the place where I marked the route. Photo #5 shows the route by the disturbed soil path going South towards the loader.
14. If the marker in photo #5 is HTC's, and it properly marks their underground utility, the distance between the marker and the excavation path appears to not be a conflict. HTC's cable appears to jog West just North of the marker in photo #5. I do not remember if HTC utility flags conflicted with the disturbed soil path depicted in photo #5, even when looking North through location where HTC's line was cut.
15. I cannot speak to who the person in photo #1 is, when the photo was taken, or where it was taken. However, I recall seeing third party locators at or near the Excavation Site. I recall one or more of the locators telling me that they were struggling with locating in the area near the Excavation Site because of the many existing underground utilities.


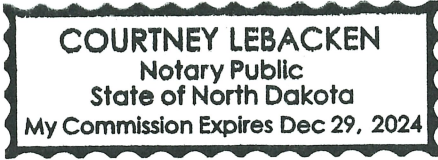
