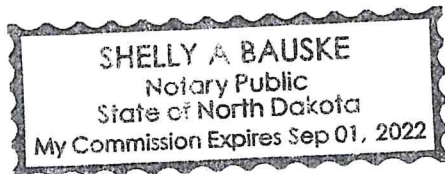


NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

June 8, 2022

On August 4, 2010, in Case No. PU-10-147 the Commission adopted Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issuing Certificate of Site Compatibility Number 17, to Ashtabula Wind III (Ashtabula III) designating a site for its Ashtabula III Wind Energy Center in Barnes County North Dakota.

On May 16, 2022, in Case No. PU-22-195, Ashtabula III, and Otter Tail Power Company (OTP) filed a joint application to transfer Certificate Number 17 from Ashtabula III to OTP.

The issues to be considered in Case No. PU-22-195 are whether OTP agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of the certificate and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

Those interested are invited to comment in writing on the application in Case No. PU-22-195. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by July 22, 2022.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
