



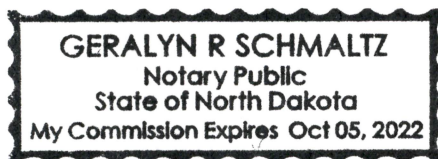

Preliminary Statement

On March 17, 2022, the Public Service Commission received the application for Revision No. 12 to Surface Coal Mining Permit NACC-1302 from Coyote Creek Mining Company, L.L.C. for its Coyote Creek Mine south of Zap in Mercer County. Revision No. 12 changes the post mine topography on 280 acres in Sections 6 and 7, T142N, R88W and Section 1, T142N, R89W. The introductory, legal, financial, compliance information, environmental, operations and reclamation sections have been revised.

The Commission received a request for an Informal Conference on the application from Casey and Julie Voigt with concerns about dust, projected topsoil and subsoil respread depths, reclamation variances, and the timing of revegetation.
