

[¶ 5] As a result, the Public Service Commission is requesting until July 21, 2023 to file a certified copy of the record of proceedings. In the event of earlier receipt of the transcription, the agency will file the records as soon as administratively possible.

[¶ 6] The Public Service Commission has communicated with counsel for Coyote Creek Mining Company and the Voigts that additional time may be needed to provide a certified record.

[¶ 7] WHEREFORE, the Public Service Commission respectfully requests this Court issue an order granting an extension until July 21, 2023 to file a certified copy of the record of proceedings before the agency.
