Revision 12 to Permit NACC-1302 at Coyote Creek Mine adds sediment pond designs, revises the post mine topography of state and privately surface (over state- and privately-owned coal) in Sections 1, 6, and 7, revises the reclamation schedule and variance maps and updates the worst-case

bond estimate. This revision does not impact federal coal and I don't believe it meets the criteria in 746.18. Coyote Creek has obtained a federal coal lease for tracts in Sections 24 and 26, but is waiting on mine plan approval.
