

The Brady II Wind Energy Center (“Brady Wind II”) is located in Hettinger and Stark Counties, North Dakota. The project has a nameplate capacity of 149.0 megawatts (MW) consisting of 72 wind turbines using 65 General Electric (GE) 2.1 MW wind turbine generators and 7 GE 1.79 MW wind turbine generators. Additional facilities include access roads, electrical collection systems and cabling and meteorological towers. The project has been in production since December 2016 and is not expected to retire in the next ten years. A Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) is in place through the end of December 2046.

2. Projected Retirement Date: The facility is not projected to retire within the next ten-year period.

Power from Brady Wind II connects to the 230 kV transmission line owned by Basin Electric Power Cooperative via the approximately 19-mile 230 kV transmission line associated with the Brady Wind Energy Center. No transmission facilities were built as part of Brady Wind II.


