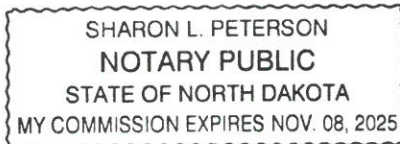

The NDDOT may adjust the awarded amounts to qualify public transit operators when the FTA 2023 appropriation is available.

All public transit operators and providers are encouraged to apply. Individuals are not eligible for these funds. All new transit operators applying for funding should review the NDDOT Transit Grant Application Guidelines.

2. The true and correct name of the Plaintiff is Amex B. Johnson Jr., who was born in 1990, and who is thirty-two (32) years of age. The Plaintiff currently resides at 5280 28th Ave S., Apt. 101, Fargo, North Dakota 58104. Plaintiff is represented in this proceeding by Joshua Nyberg of Nyberg Law Office, PLLC. Plaintiff's Social Security Number is xxx-xx-7906.

3. The true and correct name of the Defendant is Rose T. Richardson, who was born in 1985, and who is thirty-six (36) years of age. The Defendant resides at 639 33rd Ave W., Apt. 301, West Fargo, North Dakota 58078. Defendant is unrepresented. Defendant's Social Security Number is xxx-xx-8103.

4. The parties are residents of the State of North Dakota and have been residents for at least the last six (6) months.

5. Neither party is currently an active duty member of the United States Armed Forces.

6. The parties were never married to one another but did have an intimate encounter that the Defendant told the Plaintiff resulted in the birth of one child, namely R.M.J., born in 2021.

7. The Defendant lied and had the Plaintiff put himself on the birth certificate knowing that he was not the father of R.M.J., born in 2021.

8. The Plaintiff took it upon himself to get a paternity test done in May of 2022 as he was not totally sure the child was his. After taking retail paternity test the results show there is a zero percent chance the Plaintiff is the biological father of R.M.J.

9. Genetic testing with a clear chain of custody is needed to confirm the earlier results and to provide results acceptable to the court.

10. To the best of the Plaintiff's knowledge, no separate proceeding for parental rights and responsibilities is currently pending in the State of North Dakota, nor within the court of any other jurisdiction.

11. That the Plaintiff's name should be removed from the minor child's birth certificate, and the Plaintiff should be absolved of any responsibility or rights to the minor child.

12. Each party should be responsible for their own attorney's fees and costs.

13. WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests the Court enter an Order:

A. That paternity between the Plaintiff and the minor child be disestablished.

B. That the Plaintiff's name be taken off the minor child's birth certificate immediately.

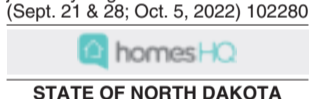
C. That the Plaintiff shall have no rights to and know financial responsibility for the minor child.
