NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR CONSOLIDATED HEARING

On October 14, 2022, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., an electric public utility, filed applications under North Dakota Century Code Chapter 49-03 to extend service to Applied Blockchain at two locations in Dickey County, North Dakota.

Submitted with the applications were statements by Applied Blockchain that it desires electric service to be provided by the applicant at both locations. Service is to be provided at points located in:

The SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 129 North, Range 63 West, Dickey County, North Dakota, and

The NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 129 North, Range 63 West, Dickey County, North Dakota.

Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer at both locations.

Any interested party has the right to file written objections, based on issues of public convenience and necessity, with the Commission by **December 12, 2022**, and the matters will then be set for hearings. If no objections are received by that date, the applications may be granted as requested.
