

APPEARANCE OF BIAS IN A QUASI-JUDICIAL PROCEEDING DISCLOSURE FORM

Pursuant to N.D.A.C 115-05-01-03 and N.D.A.C. 115-05-01-06, disclosure of the potential appearance of bias in Quasi-Judicial proceeding is required. This allows directors, officers, commissioners, heads, or other executives of agencies to input information and attach relevant documentation.

The Neutral Reviewer or director, officer, commissioner, head, or other executive shall document the facts and decision regarding any disclosures. Upon completion, the Neutral Reviewer or director, officer, commissioner, head, or other executive shall provide a copy of the form to the North Dakota Ethics Commission.

Departments, agencies, boards, commissions or public entities shall document in the official minutes of a proceeding information, if applicable, that a director, officer, commissioner, head, or other executive has been recused from any further involvement in the matter.
