Objection to the Filing of Additional Responses to SCS Carbon Transport LLC's Renewal of Its Motion to Declare Burleigh and Emmons County Ordinances Superseded and Preempted

SCS Carbon Transport LLC ("Summit") objects to the filing of additional responses to Summit's renewed Motion to Declare Burleigh and Emmons County Ordinances Superseded and Preempted ("Renewal Motion"). *See* Docket No. 401. The North Dakota Public Service Commission ("Commission") has been fully briefed on the law and issues surrounding Summit's original Motion to Declare Burleigh and Emmons County Ordinances Superseded and Preemption as a matter of law.

Summit filed its Renewal Motion in response to the comments made by the Commission at its September 15, 2023 special meeting regarding the issue of local ordinance preemption. In its Renewal Motion, Summit requests that the Commission render a decision on the issue of automatic preemption prior to the rehearing on Summit's Petition for Reconsideration. The issue is purely one of law and Summit's Renewal Motion does not make any new arguments (legal or otherwise) not already made or set forth in its original Preemption Motion. Accordingly, it is not proper for the Commission to allow the intervenors another opportunity to respond in opposition to the same.

Based on the foregoing, Summit respectfully requests that the Commission deny the intervenors an opportunity to file additional responses or pleadings on the issue of local ordinance preemption and requests that the Commission proceed to render a decision on Summit's request based on the pleadings already in the record.
