REQUEST FOR SUPPLEMENTAL FILING AND DATA REQUEST 3

The Public Service Commission (Commission) submits the following request for filing and data requests to SCS Carbon Transport LLC (SCS). The Commission requests that SCS provide the requested filings at such time that it believes it has sufficient data and supporting documentation to adequately address the requested filings. The Commission requests that SCS provide answers to the data requests within 14 days of receipt.

Requested Filings:

3.1 The Commission requests a supplemental filing in a form consistent with North Dakota Administrative Code chapter 69-06 providing updated information and addressing the siting criteria for all current proposed reroutes. The supplemental filing must include the following:

3.1.1. Detailed maps and available survey and studies along the proposed reroutes. The supplemental filing must identify the percentage of land surveyed by county.

3.1.2. Updated agency consultations on the proposed reroutes.

3.1.3. Measures taken to address all landowners who testified regarding concerns during the hearings.

3.1.4. A review of all areas prone to landslide or geologic instability discussed by the North Dakota Geological Survey and a demonstration that no landslide prone areas identified by the North Dakota Geological Survey are within the project corridor.

3.1.5. A comprehensive analysis of a southern route around Bismarck. The analysis should compare relative adverse effects to the proposed route.

Data Requests:

3.2 Please Identify by county any landowners and parcels crossed by the proposed corridor that were not crossed by the originally proposed corridor.

3.3. Please identify what percentage of easements have been obtained by county.

3.4. The Petition for Reconsideration noted efforts underway or completed to address the concerns of 4 separate landowners who voiced concerns during the hearing. What is the status of each of the reroutes or efforts to satisfy those landowners?

3.5. What is the current number of suppliers signed up to utilize the proposed pipeline.

3.6. Please provide a description of the pipeline's operations in relation to currently proposed injection fields.

3.7. What is the status of federal and state permits for the proposed Missouri River crossing?
