Dear Mr. Kahl:

This letter is in response to SCS Carbon Transport LLC's ("Summit") Response to Supplemental Filing Request 3.1.3 to the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("Commission") dated March 4, 2024 (PSC Doc. 452). The information provided in this Response is misleading.

As a beginning point, the original request from the Commission sought "[m]easures taken to address <u>all</u> landowners who testified regarding concerns during the hearings." Supplemental Filing 3.1.3 (emphasis added). Summit's letter suggests that it has addressed all of the Landowners who testified regarding concerns with the pipeline on their property. This would be an incorrect conclusion by the PSC.

I compared Judge Hogan's witness lists and my hearing notes to Summit's response. The following names are Landowner Intervenors who are listed on Judge Hogan's hearing sheets as having testified regarding their concerns with the proposed route and are still affected by the pipeline route based on our route comparisons:

- 1. Mary Jo Irmeni Burleigh County (June 2, 2023 hearing)
- 2. Linda Gaymanii Dickey County (May 9, 2023 hearing)
- 3. James Tiegsⁱⁱⁱ Dickey County (April 11, 2023 hearing)
- 4. Valera Hayeniv Sargent County (April 11, 2023 hearing)
- 5. Staroba Living Trust Loren Staroba^v Richland County (April 11, 2023 hearing); see also PSC Doc. 188 (exhibits from Staroba testimony):

6. Shirley Walochvi - Sargent County (March 28, 2023 hearing)

Summit does not identify any measures it has taken to address these "landowners who testified regarding concerns during the hearings."

In addition, James Rockstad^{vii} and Diann Zajac^{viii} provided written testimony to the PSC regarding their opposition to the pipeline on their property. See (PSC Doc. 272 (Rockstad) and PSC Doc. 296 (Zajac)). Summit does not identify any measures it has taken to address these "landowners who testified regarding concerns during the hearings." Justin and Danielle Buckingham from Mandan also articulated objections to the pipeline on their property at the final Bismarck hearing. They are not my clients and I do not know of any discussions between Summit and the Buckinghams. However, the Buckinghams are also omitted from Summit's March 4, 2024 letter (PSC Doc. 452). I do not know whether the concerns of any other landowners who provided sworn testimony before the PSC—but are unrepresented—remain similarly ignored.

Furthermore, Summit's willingness to accommodate North Dakota citizens appears to extend only as far as the PSC requires. The following Landowner Intervenors have formally objected to this pipeline being placed on their property and Summit does not identify any measures taken to address their concerns:

Most of these people were unable to attend local hearings for various personal reasons or scheduling conflicts. Some of them did attend but were unable to testify due to the time limitations. If these people must testify live in order to receive any accommodations from Summit, we want the opportunity for them to do so.
