Response of SCS Carbon Transport LLC to the Testimony of Chad Moldenhauer

SCS Carbon Transport LLC ("Summit"), by and through its attorneys of record, responds to the testimony provided by Chad Moldenhauer at the April 22, 2024 public hearing in Mandan, North Dakota as follows:

- 1. On April 22, 2024, Mr. Wade Boeshans, Executive Vice-President of Summit Carbon Solutions, LLC, the parent company of Summit, adopted written testimony and testified orally before the North Dakota Public Service Commission describing, among other things, his communications with Chad Moldenhauer, John Warford, and Chad Watcher in August 2023.
 - 2. Specifically, Mr. Boeshans' written testimony provides:
 - ... we reached out to some of the Bismarck area intervenors and held meetings to identify and align on specific concerns related to impacts on residential development and property values. We contacted Mr. Moldenhauer, Mr. Warford and Mr. Wachter and met with Mr. Warford and Mr. Watcher on several occasions.

. . . .

I learned that they are not opposed to Summit's project, but they had concerns related to the location of the pipeline, impacts on the future growth of Bismarck and safety concerns. I received valuable input and advice that I included in our plan. I believe they were constructive meetings.

3. At the hearing on April 22, 2024, Mr. Boeshans testified:

So after the -- the denial of the previous route, you know, we met as a team, looked at the findings of fact, after which I reached out to the Bismarck Area Intervenors, and I met with or contacted all of them, met with some of them several times to just better understand what -- what their concerns were.

. . . .

And so as I mentioned, had numerous meetings with the -- with the Bismarck Area Intervenors. Again, after that, I learned, you know, really their primary concerns, and you know, got some input on how to address them.

See Docket No. 535 (emphasis added).

4. At the hearing on April 22, 2024, Mr. Moldenhauer confirmed that Mr. Boeshans had communicated with him when Mr. Moldenhauer testified:

And then, you know, on that 23rd e-mail, we decided that we were going to have a meeting on September 7th. Shortly after that 23rd e-mail, I was informed that there was a new route that was posted. The route looked the same, at least as far as northern Bismarck was concerned to the one we had seen prior to the last public hearing. And so I messaged Mr. Boeshans back, and I said, I don't believe that a meeting to determine route feasibility would be appropriate now that Summit has already presented an alternative route in its petition for reconsideration. I will pass on the meeting at this time.

Id.

5. Mr. Moldenhauer further testified that:

Any assertions made by Mr. Boeshans or Summit Carbon Solutions that I participated in their decision to place this route where it is right now is a lie and a complete fabrication.

. . . .

So to -- to say that I was, you know, in cahoots with Summit in generating this new pipeline route is just -- is just inaccurate.

Id.

6. Summit agrees with Mr. Moldenhauer that any assertion that he or the other Bismarck Area Intervenors participated in Summit's decision to place the route at its current location would not be accurate. However, Mr. Boeshans' testimony, both written and oral, is clear that Mr. Boeshans merely asked for Mr. Moldenhauer's and the other Bismarck Area Intervenors' input and listened to their concerns.
