

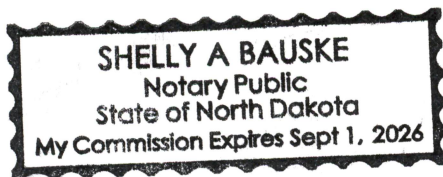

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

November 30, 2022

On November 1, 2022, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (MDU), filed a change to its Generation Resource Recovery Rate (GRRR) rates to reflect 2023 projected costs for its Lewis & Clark Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engine units.

The effect of the rate change on the bill for a residential customer using 894 kWh per month is a decrease of \$0.13 per month or \$1.56 per year compared with the existing GRRR rate.

The issues to consider in this proceeding are:


1. Whether the investments and associated costs for the resources qualify for recovery?
2. Whether the incurred costs are reasonable and prudent?
3. Whether the rate adjustments are consistent with MDU's tariff?

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by January 13, 2023.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
