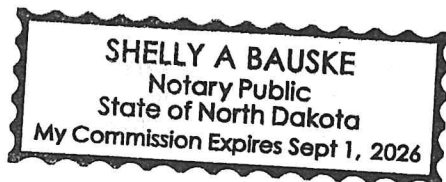


NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On April 8, 2015, in Case No. PU-14-689 the Commission adopted Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issuing Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 164, and Route Permit Number 176, to Caliber Midstream Partners, L.P., for the construction, operation, and maintenance of approximately 4.4 miles of 6-inch natural gas liquids pipeline and associated facilities in McKenzie County, North Dakota. On April 29, 2015, the Commission amended its original Order and issued the First Amended Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 164, and First Amended Route Permit Number 176, to Caliber Midstream Partners, L.P.

On December 1, 2022, in Case No. PU-22-416, Caliber Midstream Partners, L.P., and Caliber North Dakota filed a joint application to transfer Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 164 and Route Permit Number 176 from Caliber Midstream Partners, L.P. to Caliber North Dakota.

The issues to be considered in Case No. PU-22-416 are whether Caliber North Dakota agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of the certificate and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by February 24, 2023.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
