5. Pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 49-22.1-01(3)(a) and Certification Relating to Order Provision No. 32, ONEOK hereby provides the Commission with written notice of its intent to undertake certain minor in-facility project improvements. ONEOK proposes to relocate the two leak detection skids at Antelope Creek Junction. The two leak detection skids originally proposed will remain within the existing footprint of Antelope Creek Junction however, their location will shift within the existing certificated corridor approved by the Order and certificated by the First Amended Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 203 (the “Project”). Attached hereto as Exhibit A, is an updated plot plan reflecting the new location of the two leak detection skids withing the existing corridor at Antelope Creek Junction.
6. Activities for construction of the Project will occur wholly within the geographic location for which ONEOK previously obtained a certificate of corridor compatibility. *See* N.D.C.C. § 49-22.1-01(3)(a).
7. Construction of the Project is for the same type of facility as approved by the Order. *See* N.D.C.C. § 49-22.1-01(3)(a)(1).
8. Pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 49-22.1-01(3)(a)(4),
  - a. Activities for construction of the Project will not affect a known exclusion or avoidance area;
  - b. The activities are to improve the existing natural gas liquids transmission facility; and
  - c. ONEOK will continue to comply with the Order and will continue to comply with all applicable conditions and protections in siting laws and rules and Commission orders previously issued for any part of the project.
