Customers will be notified in advance of a company-initiated suspension or termination of service under this provision.

2.2 ESTABLISHING AND FURNISHING SERVICE

2.2.9 TERMINATION OF SERVICE - COMPANY INITIATED (Cont'd)

F. Restoration of Service

1. If the service furnished a customer is temporarily suspended for nonpayment of charges due or for any other violation of the regulations of the Company, such service is restored only upon payment of a restoration of service charge consisting of one service ordering charge and one central office access charge for each system restored at the rates shown in Section 3 of this Catalog.
2. In cases where the facilities have been completely disconnected because of discontinuance of service for nonpayment of charges due or for any other violation of the regulations of the Company, service is reestablished only upon payment of the charges that would apply for a new customer establishing service. Such charges are in addition to any charges due for services and facilities furnished up to the date of suspension of service and are found in this Section.
3. When a customer fails to pay outstanding charges for MTS calls provided by the Local Exchange Company, (e.g., 0+, 1+, 0-, 101XXXX), all MTS service will be denied. This includes denial for third number billed, collect, and calling card calls. If the customer's main line service remains connected, MTS will be reestablished only upon payment of all outstanding MTS charges in addition to the following MTS Restoration Charge.

G. Customer Denied Access

The Company may either temporarily suspend service or terminate the service to any person, firm or corporation who fails to respond or who otherwise denies the Company access to the premises when such access is deemed necessary by the Company to maintain, transfer or otherwise modify service. The Company shall notify the customer at least 30 days prior to service suspension or termination. The Company shall waive any associated reconnection charges if such reconnection is made within 30 days, except that the Company does not guarantee the same phone number will be available if reconnection is requested.
