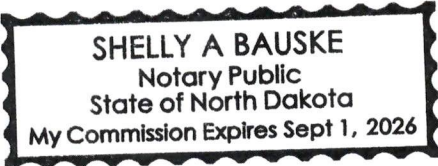

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On July 25, 2023, Otter Tail Power Company (OTP) filed an application to change its tariff related to the new AMDT. OTP also requested a permanent variance to North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-09-02-10 & 69-09-02-11 relating to the required frequency of meter readings and bill presentation.

The issues to consider in this proceeding are:

1. Are the proposed tariff revisions just and reasonable?
2. Do the proposed rates comply with the tariff?
3. Are the proposed rates just and reasonable?
4. Whether the requested variance should be granted?

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by October 20, 2023.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.


