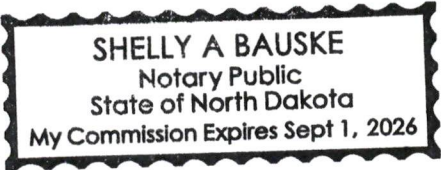

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On August 17, 2023, Otter Tail Power Company (OTP) filed an application for approval to change the Rate Schedules 14.02 and 14.03 to close the rates that are using Real Time Pricing and System Marginal Energy Pricing for new customers. The current software required for these tariffs reaches end of life in 2025 and OTP is selecting new software and would like to avoid causing confusion to new customers that might result from methodology changes in this process. The tariff revisions would have no impact on the rates for North Dakota customers.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Whether the proposed tariff changes are reasonable, and
2. Whether the tariff changes should be approved.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by October 16, 2023.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.
