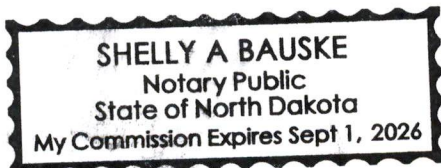

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NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR CONSOLIDATED HEARING

On August 31, 2023, Dakota Natural Gas, LLC (DNG) filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate a natural gas distribution system to serve Larimore and Arvilla, North Dakota and their environs. DNG also filed an application to update its Tariff to add the new service area in Larimore and Arvilla.

The issues to be considered for the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Case No. PU-23-300 are:

1. Is there a need for the service?
2. Is DNG technically, financially and managerially fit and able to provide the service?
3. What is the effect on other public utilities providing similar service?
4. Is the proposed service adequate?


The issues to be considered for the Tariff change in Case No. PU-23-301 are:

1. Are the proposed changes reasonable?
2. Is there other relevant information the Commission should consider?

Those interested are invited to comment on the applications in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by October 20, 2023.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.
