 DAKOTA VALLEY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE (DVEC) CONTACTED OTTER TAIL POWER COMPANY (OTP) ON OCTOBER 2, 2023 INQUIRING IF OTP WOULD PROVIDE SERVICE TO A NEW ENVIRONMENTAL SENSOR STATION SOUTH OF JAMESTOWN ON US HWY 281. AFTER DVEC BOARD MEETING HELD ON OCTOBER 27, 2023, DVEC MANAGER OF ENGINEERING, BRANDON GIESLER, INDICATED THAT OTP COULD PURSUE SERVICE TO THE SITE. OTP HAS A DISTRIBUTION SUBSTATION APPROXIMATELY 300 FEET NORTH OF THIS SITE.
