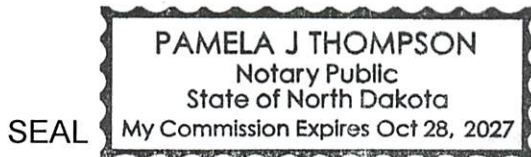

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On July 28, 2021, in Case No. PU-21-150 the Commission adopted Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issuing Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 223, and Route Permit number 233, to Dakota Gasification Company (DGC), for the construction, operation, and maintenance of approximately 2.9 miles of twelve-inch and 3.9 miles of six-inch carbon dioxide gas pipeline and associated facilities in Mercer County, North Dakota.

On November 15, 2023, in Case No. PU-23-347, DGC and Dakota Carbon LLC (DCS) filed a joint application to transfer Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 223 and Route Permit Number 233 from DGC to DCS.


The issues to be considered in Case No. PU-23-347 are whether DCS agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of the certificate and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.


Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by January 8, 2024.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
