Dear Mr. Shock:

In accordance with item 30 of the Certification Relating to Order Provisions in the above-referenced case, Basin Electric Power Cooperative (Basin Electric) is providing this notification of a personal injury that occurred at the Project construction site.

On September 2nd, 2024, at approximately 6:20pm, a construction contractor worker became unconscious while working in a man basket. The basket was immediately lowered to the ground and emergency responders were called. The employee regained consciousness after approximately 1 minute. The emergency responders transported the employee via ambulance to the McKenzie County hospital in Watford City, ND. The employee did not sustain any physical injuries as a result of becoming unconscious, nor did an injury cause the employee to become unconscious. The health professionals stated dehydration and an underlying health issue was likely to have caused the unconsciousness. The employee will take 2 to 3 days off to rest and recover.
