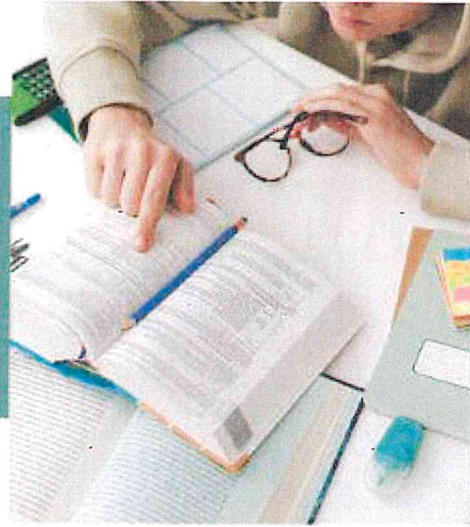

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On December 29, 2023, Northern States Power Company (NSP) filed an application for the Commission to amend its December 22, 2008, Order Adopting Settlement, and the associated settlement agreement in case PU-07-776. NSP is requesting the Commission to eliminate its requirement to file advanced determinations of prudence for certain new transmission and generation additions.

The issue to be considered in this proceeding is whether it is appropriate for the Commission to amend its December 22, 2008, Order Adopting Settlement.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by January 30, 2024.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.
