**MOTION FOR ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE**

COMES NOW Dave Tschider, of the firm Tschider & Smith, 2005 N. Kavaney Dr., Suite 100, Bismarck, ND 58502, and hereby moves the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to Rule 3 of the North Dakota Rules of Admission to Practice, for an Order granting the admission of John B. Coffman to appear *pro hac vice* in the above-captioned matter. Grounds for this motion are as follows:

1. John B. Coffman has 35 years of experience as an attorney and utility rate expert. He routinely appears and participates in matters before other state public utility commissions, including rate case appearances in Missouri, Illinois, Florida, Georgia, Alabama, New Jersey, Colorado, South Carolina, Arizona, California, Kansas, Alaska, and Minnesota. He is best positioned to represent AARP, with the Commission's permission *pro hac vice*, in this proceeding.
2. John B. Coffman is admitted to practice law in the state of Missouri and is a member in good standing of said bar (MoBar #36591). Attached herewith as Exhibit A is the affidavit as required by Rule 3 of the North Dakota Rules of Admission to Practice.

3. John B. Coffman is not presently, and has never been, subject to a public disciplinary proceeding.
4. John B. Coffman is not under any restriction or probation in the practice of law in any jurisdiction in which he is licensed.
5. John B. Coffman is not, and has never been, suspended or disbarred from a court in any jurisdiction.
6. Over the past three years, John B. Coffman has appeared in four North Dakota administrative proceedings in which he was granted *pro hac vice* status under North Dakota Supreme Court Rule to Admission to Practice 3. All four proceedings were rate cases at the Commission: an Xcel NSP electric rate case (Case No. PU-20-441), an Xcel NSP natural gas rate case (Case No. PU-21-381), an MDU electric rate case (Case No. PU-22-194), and most recently, an MDU natural gas rate case (Case No. PU-23-341).
7. John B. Coffman has concurrently sent a copy of this motion and affidavit to the State Board of Law Examiners.
8. John B. Coffman has previously remitted to the State Board of Law Examiners the required fee of \$380.00 for *pro hac vice* admission for 2024.
9. John B. Coffman is associated in this matter with undersigned counsel, Dave Tschider, 2005 N. Kavaney Dr., Suite 100, Bismarck, ND 58502, an attorney who is admitted and licensed to practice law in the State of North Dakota.

10. Pursuant to Rule 3 of the North Dakota Rules of Admission to Practice, I respectfully request the Commission issue an Order granting permission for John B. Coffman to practice before the Commission *pro hac vice*.

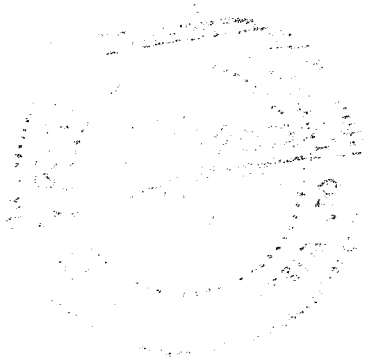
