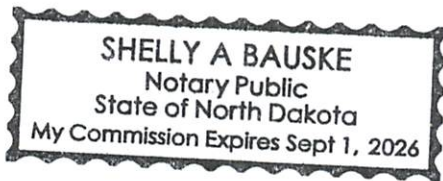

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On February 14, 2024, Otter Tail Power Company (OTP) filed an application for approval to implement a new My Renewable Energy Credits Rider (My RECs). The new service offering will be a voluntary rider that will allow nonresidential customers with demand over 20 kW an opportunity to offset carbon associated with their energy use by utilizing OTP's excess generated Renewable Energy Credits (RECs). Customers will have the option to participate at 50%, 75%, or 100% of their usage at a per kWh charge based on the currently approved Small Power Producer rate and an administrative charge for processing and retiring OTP's excess RECs.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Are the proposed tariff revisions just and reasonable?
2. Do the proposed rates comply with the tariff?
3. Are the proposed rates just and reasonable?

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by April 19, 2024.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.
