NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING
On April 8, 2015, in Case No. PU-14-689, the Commission adopted Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issuing Certificate of Corridor Compatibility number 164 and Route Permit number 176, to Caliber Midstream Partners (n/k/a Caliber Midstream Partners LLC), for the construction, operation, and maintenance of approximately 4.4 miles of six-inch natural gas pipeline and associated facilities in McKenzie County, North Dakota. On January 11, 2023, in Case No. PU-21-441, the Commission adopted Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issuing Certificate of Corridor Compatibility number 229 and Route Permit number 239, to Caliber Midstream Partners (n/k/a Caliber Midstream Partners LLC), for the construction, operation, and maintenance of approximately 2.62 miles of eight-inch natural gas pipeline and associated facilities in McKenzie County, North Dakota. On February 16, 2024, Caliber North Dakota LLC and Valence Natural Gas Solutions LLC filed with the Commission a joint application to transfer Certificate Numbers 164 and 229 and Permit Numbers 176 and 239 to Valence Natural Gas Solutions LLC. The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Whether Valence agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of Certificate number 164 and Permit number 176 issued on April 8, 2015, and Certificate number 229 and Permit number 239 issued on January 11, 2023, respectively; and
2. Whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearing must be received by April 19, 2024. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing. Notice is hereby given that the deadline for filing to have a candidate's name printed on the ballot for Parshall School District is April 8th, 2024, by 4:00 p.m. The following offices are up for election:

- A resident from that portion of the City of Parshall which is south of 2nd Ave N, excluding Block 001, with only those qualified electors legally residing in this area eligible to be candidates for this Board position.
- A resident from that portion of the City of Parshall which includes Block 001 and all other areas north of 2nd Ave N, with only those qualified electors residing in this area eligible to be candidates for this Board position.

A candidate for a school district office must prepare and sign a document stating the candidate's name and the position for which the individual is a candidate, and a SNF 10172 Statement of Interests form. Both of these documents must be filed with the school district business manager for Parshall School District by the above deadline date and time.
