[PROPOSED] ORDER ON APPELLANTS' MOTION TO RECONSIDER OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, TO MODIFY ORDER DENYING STAY

The Court has considered Appellants' Motion to Reconsider or, in the Alternative, to Modify the October 8, 2025 Order Denying Motion to Stay Enforcement Pending Appeal, any responses, and the existing record.

Pursuant to N.D.R. Civ. P. 54(b) and N.D.C.C. § 28-32-48, and to preserve the Court's jurisdiction and ensure orderly adjudication of the issues on appeal,

# IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Reconsideration Granted Limited Stay of Enforcement. Enforcement of the Public Service Commission's June 18, 2025 order (which left in place the November 20, 2024 Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") challenged in this appeal) is stayed to the following limited extent: pending resolution of this appeal, the PSC and the parties in PSC Siting Docket PU-25-236 shall not cite to, rely upon, or otherwise give operative effect to the November 20, 2024 CPCN as evidentiary or legal support for "need" or as predicate authority in that docket, including in staff recommendations, notices, testimony, filings, and hearing presentations.
- 2. **No Stay of Other PSC Proceedings.** Nothing in this Order stays other proceedings or deadlines in PU-25-236; the PSC may proceed consistent with Paragraph 1.
- 3. **Alternative Relief.** In the alternative, if reconsideration is denied, the October 8, 2025 order is modified/clarified to the same limited extent stated in Paragraph 1.
