### NOTICE

The Appellant Brief was filed March 26, 2026. The following corrections are required for your brief:

1. It appears there is single-spaced text on the table of contents, table of authorities and footnotes within the brief that should be double-spaced. The rules require that text must be double-spaced, except headings and quotations may be single-spaced and indented. Footnotes must be double-spaced and must be in the same typeface as the text.

Please make the required corrections to the brief and resubmit it with proof of service of the corrections on opposing counsel no later than March 30, 2026. No other changes to the brief may be made. There is no need to put amended or corrected on the title page.

These corrections do not affect the time to file any Appellee brief. Therefore, the Appellee's brief will be due thirty (30) days following service of the Appellant brief filed March 26, 2026. This matter will be placed on an appropriate calendar of the Court when the Appellee's Brief has been received or when the time for filing such brief has expired.

It appears the requested corrections may cause the Appellant Brief to exceed the page limit. Under N.D.R.App.P. 32, a principal brief may not exceed 38 pages. If the requested corrections cause the Appellant Brief to exceed the page limit, an amended brief must be filed no later than March 30, 2026. If an amended brief is filed, Appellee briefs will be due following service of the amended appellants' brief.
