Please do and be aware of the following:

- 1. We do not guarantee argument will be scheduled or guarantee accommodation of conflicts, and if no conflicts are received, oral argument will be scheduled without further contact.

- 2. Oral argument generally will be held in-person, unless otherwise scheduled by this Court. If those permitted to participate in argument agree to reliable electronic means – currently Zoom - they must confer and send one collective response in writing immediately, but no later than 10 days from this notice; this response can be informal. Please be aware that the calendar may need to be finalized before the expiration of 10 days. Requests for Zoom are not guaranteed.**
 - a. If oral argument is held by Zoom, it is expected appearances will be made with video by those arguing.**

3. **N.D.R.App.P. 34 regarding oral argument was amended effective August 1, 2021. Under N.D.R.App.P. 28, any party who desires oral argument must conspicuously state on the cover of their principle brief “oral argument requested.” If you did not comply specifically with this requirement and wish to participate in argument, you must serve and file written notice of intent to participate within five days of the notice from this office stating the date, time, and place for argument. That notice will be sent at a later date when the calendar is finalized. Absent proper notice of intent to participate, you will not be permitted to argue.**
