Damage Prevention,

I have an important update regarding this UA and how we want to proceed on the reporting specifically for Farden Construction. Chad Mosser and I were scheduled to drive to Maxbass to try and meet with either Steve or Todd Farden (owners), and prior to the trip I was able to speak with both Todd and Steve Farden regarding the most recent violation that occurred at tract # GG-85-9 near Glenburn Station in ND. At the time of the violation, Larry Stone encountered a representative from Cobra, Arrow, and Farden, however, per Todd Farden, he was there dropping off a piece of equipment that Cobra Oil had requested to rent from Farden that same day after encountering frost that their equipment was unable to penetrate. Todd Farden further explained that Tyler Thompson from Cobra was the lead at this location and Farden was not involved other than the rental of this specific piece of equipment. Todd said that if we need more information, he would be willing to attend a conference call with Cobra and Enbridge to clear this up, but wanted to be sure that we are aware that Farden had no oversight of the work at that location. I also spoke with Steve Farden and he explained that many different contractors in the area will rent equipment from Farden to save on mobilization costs and if the contractor does not own the equipment needed to complete a job.

I do believe that my calls with Steve and Todd went well and we were able to discuss several different public awareness topics and events that have occurred in the past and projects that are upcoming near Enbridge assets.

I did speak with Duane and Chad and I believe the consensus is to pull back the UA for Farden only, the UAs for Cobra and Arrow will remain unchanged.
