To Whom It May Concern:

This correspondence and attachments constitutes the response of North Central Service, Inc., a Minnesota corporation ("NCS") to the One-Call Complaint ("Complaint") filed by Cass Rural Water District ("CRWD") with the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("PSC") as the above-referenced case number.

NCS wholly denies the Complaint's allegations that damage to CRWD's water main was caused due to NCS's conduct. Rather, as set forth within the One-Call Complaint filed by NCS with PSC on August 13, 2024, any and all damage was caused solely and exclusively by CRWD's failure to properly locate its own water lines and its violations of North Dakota Century Code Sections 49-23-04(6)(b) and/or (c).

## NCS Description of Incident

A copy of NCS's Complaint as to this incident is attached and incorporated by reference.

As set forth therein, on or about June 26, 2024, NCS contacted CRWD to locate underground utilities with respect to a construction project in Cass County, North Dakota at 14611 34<sup>th</sup> Street SE, Buffalo, ND. CRWD responded by placing paint and flags on the ground.

In reliance on the location provided by CRWD, and prior to commencing excavation activities, NCS located/spotted all existing utilities near the proposed construction route. NCS proceeded with all due caution and used safe and acceptable means in proceeding with its excavation activities as required by North Dakota law.

However, on July 10, 2024, while NCS was directional drilling a new 2" fiber duct along the proposed route, approximately twelve (12) feet north of existing waterline markings provided by CRWD and approximately five (5) feet south of existing fiber, at a depth of 36" to 40" until NCS cleared all utilities, NCS had to drill at approximately six (6) feet to

go under a driveway ditch. At such point, NCS inadvertently hit a 4" main that was located approximately twelve (12) feet, one (1) inch from the existing waterline locates provided by CRWD.

At no time prior to NCS commencing its activities did CRWD notify NCS that its water facilities were installed prior to August 1, 2013 or that CRWD was unable to locate its facilities.

#### False Factual Assertions Within CRWD Complaint

Additionally, NCS must correct the record as to the following false, misleading, or incomplete factual assertions within CRWD's Complaint:

- i. CRWD Claim: "NCS failed to notify CRWD they hit the line."

NCS Response: NCS was unaware that the water line had been hit before CRWD personnel arrived to assess the damage. NCS uses water as part of its boring process, so it is typical for water/mud to come out of the boring hole. CRWD arrived and located the damage before NCS had completed its boring activities and before NCS had knowledge that the water line had been hit.

- ii. CRWD Claim: "[CRWD operator] asked the [NCS operator] if he hit a water line and he said he did about 45 minutes ago so [CRWD operator] asked [NCS operator] why he didn't call it in and [NCS operator's] response was he doesn't have time to."

NCS Response: NCS denies that the NCS operator informed the CRWD operator that NCS knew that the line had been hit. Rather, the NCS operator stated that NCS had finished the job 45 minutes ago (not that the water line had been hit 45 minutes ago). Because NCS was using 28 gpm of water to bore, NCS didn't know or think there was a water hit.

- iii. CRWD Claim: "Where the water line was damaged NCS was boring at a depth of 7'."

NCS Response: This depth was contemplated by NCS's One Call ticket, which stated a depth of 8'. Hence, CRWD had knowledge of the depth as to which NCS was operating.

- iv. CRWD Claim: "The watermain was located to the best of CRWD ability using as-builts from 1979 watermain was about 10 ft. off the mark. NCS failed to locate the watermain to determine the exact location and depth."

NCS Response: At no time prior to NCS commencing its activities did CRWD notify NCS that its water facilities were installed prior to August 1, 2013 or that CRWD was unable to locate its facilities. Hence, NCS was never provided any information that would require NCS to locate the waterline beyond two (2) feet of the edge of the assumed utility location as

marked by CRWD. See North Dakota Century Code Sections 49-23-04(6)(b).


- v. CRWD Claim: "Due to the damage that occurred CRWD had 66 customers out of water for 7 hrs until the repair was completed at 1 :30 AM. NCS went home at 8:30 pm after they hit the line."

NCS Response: NCS Foreman, Randy Halvorson, was present at the site from 7:27 PM until 11:09 PM, as verified by NCS's Verizon GPS system. See screenshot attached as Exhibit A. Mr. Halvorson left the site because CRWD personnel were making rude comments to him, including that NCS will be "out of business" after CRWD is "done with" NCS.

NCS therefore respectfully requests the PSC to dismiss the Complaint against NCS and determine that CRWD failed to comply with its obligations under North Dakota Century Code Sections 49-23-04(6)(b) and/or (c).

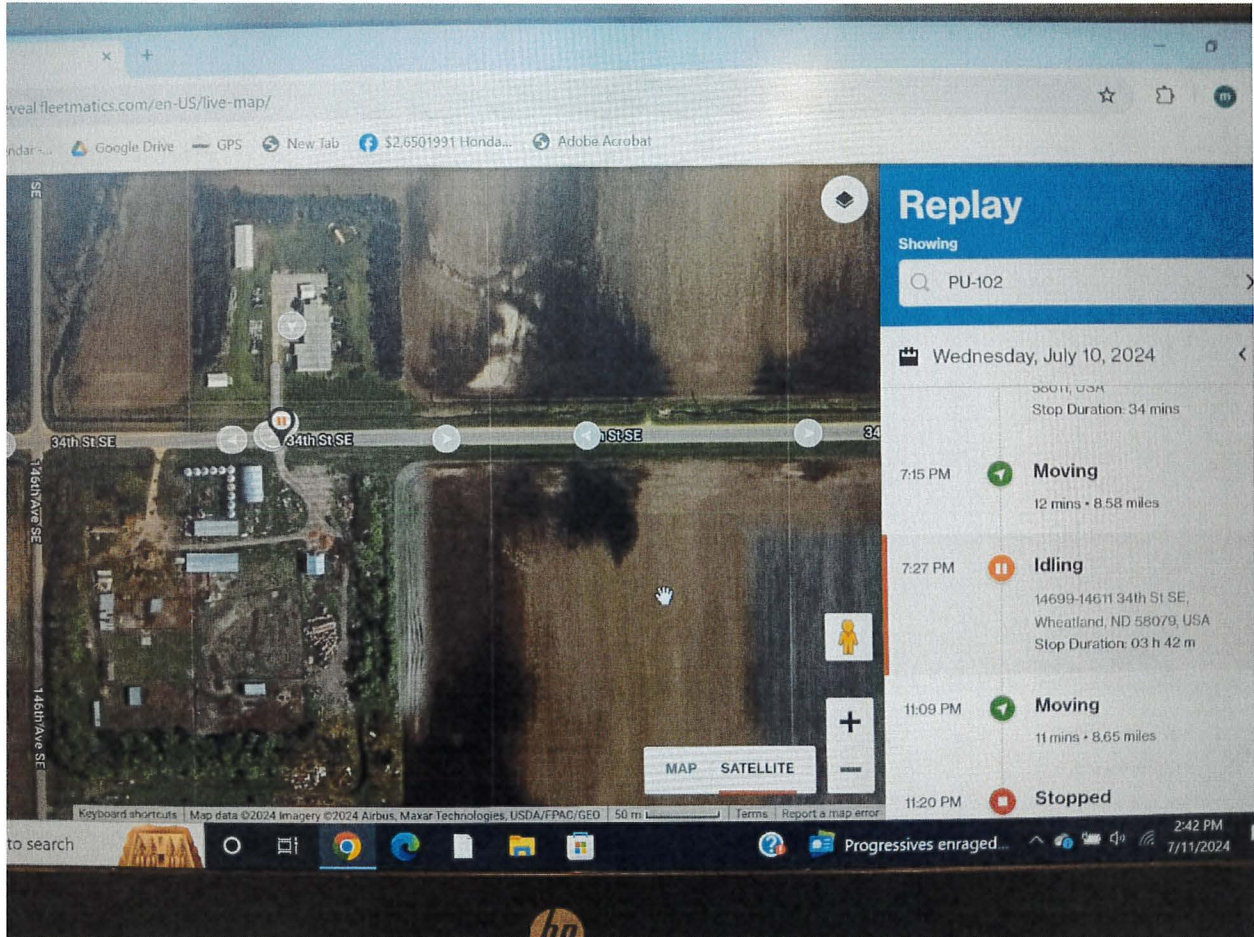

## ATTACHMENT A TO COMPLAINT

### [JULY 10, 2024 INCIDENT]

On or about June 26, 2024, North Central Service, Inc. ("NCS") contacted Cass Rural Water District ("CRWD") to locate underground utilities with respect to a construction project in Cass County, North Dakota at 14611 34<sup>th</sup> Street SE, Buffalo, ND. (See attached locate request.)

CRWD responded by placing paint and flags on the ground.

In reliance on the location provided by CRWD, and prior to commencing excavation activities, NCS located/spotted all existing utilities near the proposed construction route.

NCS proceeded with all due caution and used safe and acceptable means in proceeding with its excavation activities as required by North Dakota law.

However, on July 10, 2024, while NCS was directional drilling a new 2" fiber duct along the proposed route, approximately twelve (12) feet north of existing waterline markings provided by CRWD and approximately five (5) feet south of existing fiber, at a depth of 36" to 40" until NCS cleared all utilities, NCS had to drill at approximately six (6) feet to go under a driveway ditch. At such point, NCS inadvertently hit a 4" main that was located approximately twelve (12) feet, one (1) inch from the existing waterline locates provided by CRWD.

As soon as NCS was aware that the water line had been hit, NCS promptly informed CRWD of the damage and that the location information provided by CRWD was incorrect.

At no time prior to NCS commencing its activities did CRWD notify NCS that its water facilities were installed prior to August 1, 2013 or that CRWD was unable to locate its facilities.

Attached is a copy of NCS's damage report, which includes a drawing indicating that the water facility hit was approximately twelve (12) feet, one (1) inch from the location provided by CRWD.

Also attached are photographs of the area in question, together with a Complaint as to this incident filed by CRWD with the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("PSC") asserting a claim against NCS for damages.

NCS wholly and completely denies CRWD's Complaint, because the damages were caused solely by CRWD's failure to properly locate its own water lines as described herein.

NCS therefore respectfully requests the PSC to determine that CRWD failed to comply with its obligations under North Dakota Century Code Sections 49-23-04(6)(b) and/or (c).

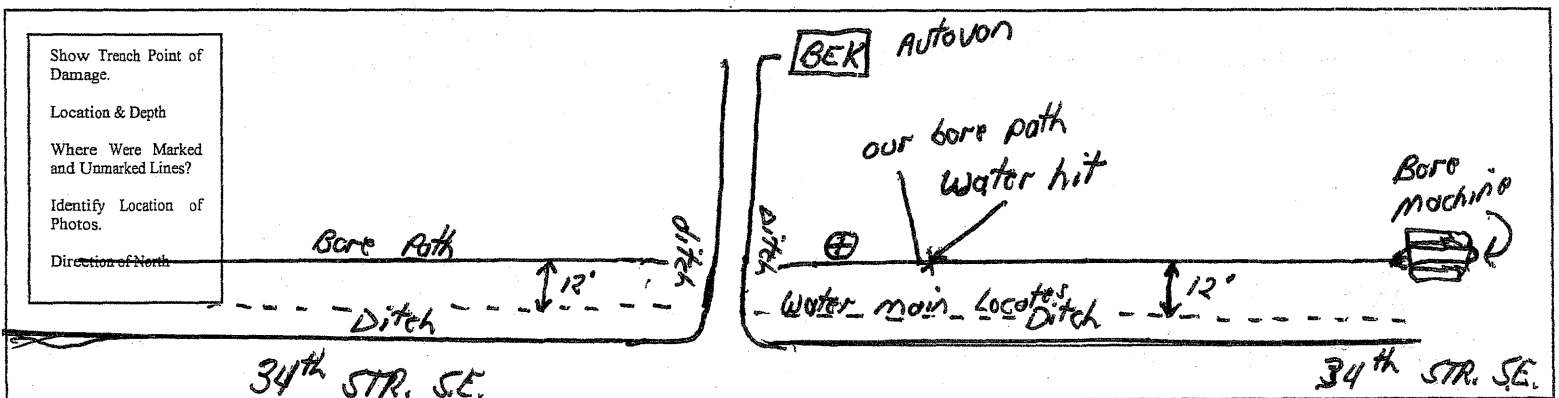

CRWD operator Tom Wilm was notified by a customer with low Pressure so he went out to investigate on his travels he seen NCS boring machine so he stopped and asked the equipment operator if he hit a water line and he said he did about 45 minutes ago so Tom asked him why he didn't call it in and his response was he doesn't have time to. NCS failed to notify CRWD that they hit the watermain. NCS was paralleling the watermain and hit it at a depth of 7 feet. They were installing fiber for BEK communications. The watermain was located to the best of CRWD ability using as-builts from 1979 watermain was about 10 ft off the mark. NCS failed to locate the watermain to determine the exact location and depth. Due to the damage that occurred CRWD had 66 customers out of water for 7 hrs until the repair was completed at 1:30 AM NCS went home at 8:30 pm after they hit the line. A bill has been sent to NCS for \$4,638.64 for the damages occurred. As you can see in the pictures they potholed every utility out there other then the water line. NCS has told use they are not going to pay the bills.

On July 10, 2024 NCS bored through 30' of 4" PVC watermain. The operator Tom Wilm was notified by a customer with low pressure. NCS failed to notify CRWD that they had hit the line. NCS was paralleling the watermain and hit it at a depth of 7'. They were installing fiber for BEK communications. The watermain was located to the best of CRW ability using as-builts from 1979. NCS failed to locate the watermain to determine the exact location and depth. Due to the damage that occurred CRW had 66 customers out of water for 7 hrs until the repair was completed. A bill has been sent to NCS for \$4,638.64 for the damages occurred.

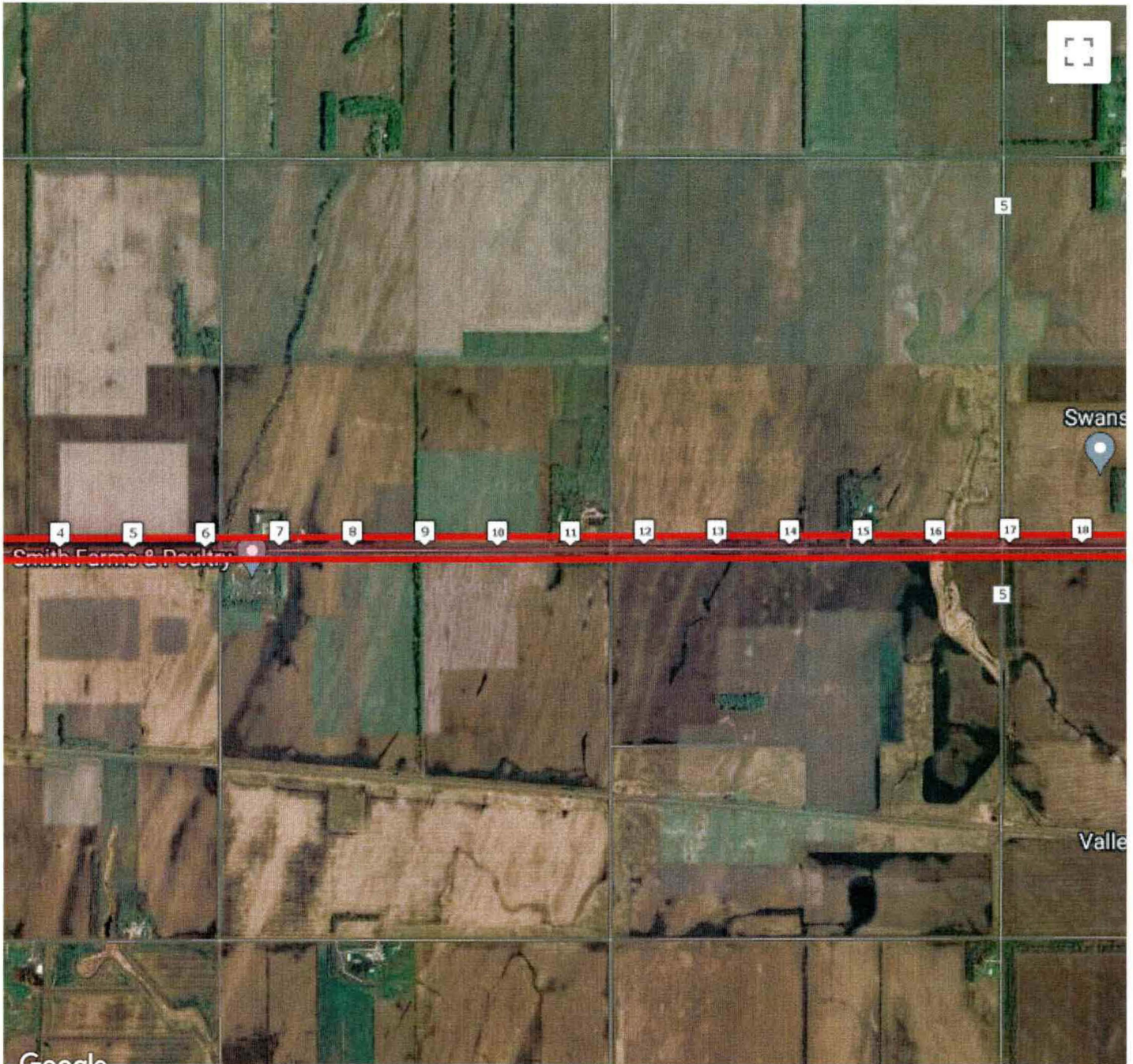
