RE: Respond to One-Call Complaint

Enclosed is the response to the complaint from North Central Services INC. and in addition we have a response to the three other times North Central Services INC. struck our line with Cass Rural Waters operators handwritten response.

I called and talked to BEK (Michael) about North Central Services first struck water line and about the ND One Call law 49-23-04 section 6-B & C. His response to me was that this matter was between Cass Rural Water and the contractor. I explained to him that all these lines were put in pre 2013 and are not always easy to locate from as-builts and we would be happy to send an operator out to help them locate the lines. Michael explained to me that he is in a time crunch because of the grant that he has received, and he was not willing to do anything that would hold up the project. After this phone call we did not talk to BEK anymore. On the same day I called and talked to Rob from Finley Engineering, he is the project manager for BEK. I explained to him that all these lines were put in pre 2013 so all we have are as-builts that are not always accurate so if they stay at 42 inches, they will never hit our line and if they must bore deeper then that they will have to look for the water line. He assured me that he would tell the contractor and the depth limit on the project was 42 inches so it shouldn't be a problem. I called Rob back two more times after North Central Services stuck our water lines. On the last strike he finally called me back. I pleaded with him to keep North Central Services at 42 inches so they wouldn't hit our lines and as of this date we have not had any other strikes to our water lines. Both my Underground Supervisor (Willie) and Operator (Lucas) have had many conversations with North Central Services Forman and office personal on ND One Call laws and the date in which the water line was installed and both have indicated to us they are not going to look for the water lines they will stay two feet away from the flags and if they hit the line it will be Cass Rural Waters, problem and they are not paying the bills to fix the water lines.

CRWD operator Lucas Ott had a locate request and located the water line with a follow up on site meeting explained to the contractor that our line is located to the best of our ability (based on 1978 asbuilts)and offered to help them pothole to determine exact location or stay at 42 inches so they don't hit us. NCS did not have a backhoe on site and didn't plan to pothole the water line and then bored the fiber line in at 7 ft deep. We could not fix the hit line that night so we temp a new line above ground for the night and then bored a new line in on 6-6-24. NCS inc confirmed to lucas that they didn't attempt to look for the water line because the flags were 20 ft away and bored their fiber in at 7 ft deep and hit the water main. Due to the hit line we had coustomers out of water for 6 hrs and 4 operators that had to work until 8:00 PM to get the water back on. |  |                                    |

On May 28, 2024, NCS bored through our 1 ½" water main in Howes township in the southwest quarter of section 14. Cass Rural Water operator Lucas Ott explained to the contractor that our line is located to the best of our ability and will need to be potholed to determine exact location. The line was installed in 1978 and is protected under ND One Call Law. NCS confirmed to Lucas and Willie that they did not attempt to look for the water main and bored anyway. Due to the line hit we had customers out of water for a total of 7 hours until the repair was completed. Where the line was damaged NCS was boring at a depth of 7'. A bill was sent to NCS for \$4,631.36 to repair the water main.

On June 5, 2024, NCS bored through 430' of 1 ½" watermain in Howes township in the northwest quarter of section 17. Once again, they did not attempt to pothole our watermain to find its exact location and were boring at a depth of 7'. Cass Rural Water operator Lucas Ott met with the contractor and explained that NCS will have to find exact location before boring and offered to help. They did not have a backhoe on site and admitted that they did not look for the watermain because they were far enough away from the flags. Cass Rural Water had to run a temporary line above ground to provide water to the customers that were affected. Cass Rural Water customers were without water for 6 hours until the repair was made. On June 6, 2024, Cass Rural Water had to bore in a new section of watermain for 430' to repair the damaged pipe. Willie Reis talked to Brian Lundborg from NCS on June 6, 2024, and was told if we want our line found we should come out in front of them and locate it for them. Willie explained that it is their responsibility to find the watermain. A bill was sent to NCS on June 7, 2024, for \$13,248.69.



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

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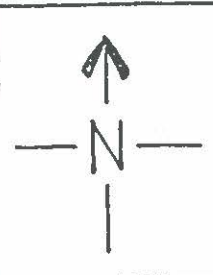



Regarding Section 17 of Howes Township

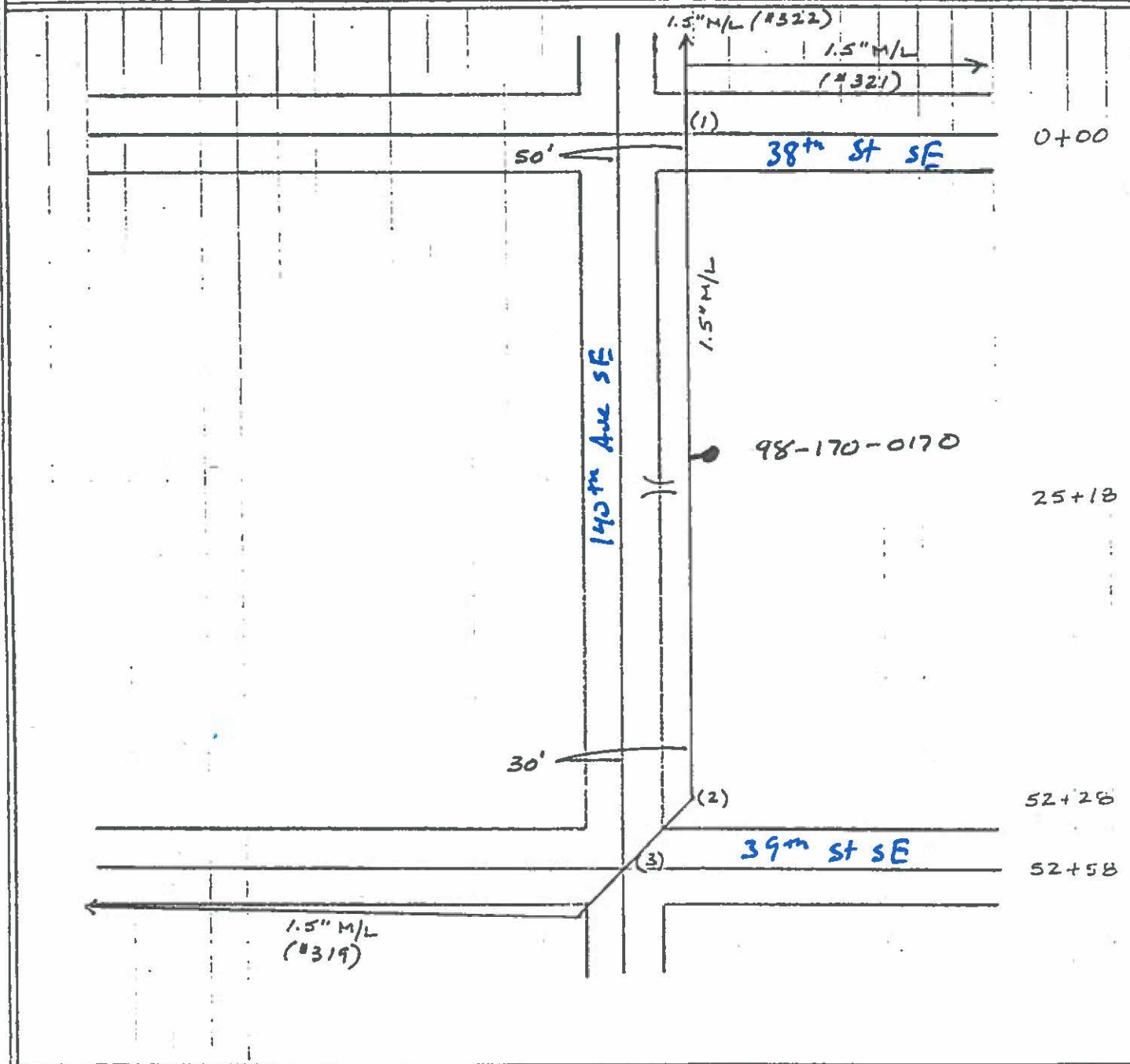

For most of the run, I was told that they would be running closer to 100' off of centerline of road and at 42", I had advised them that through out the project if they wanted help spotting CRW lines that I would accommodate them. The never attempted to spot the CRW lines in any of the instances we were struck.

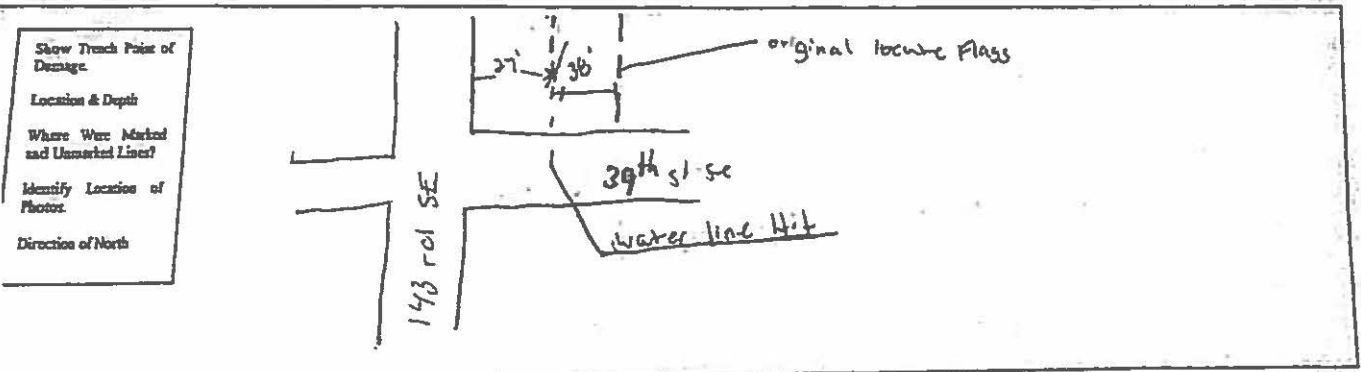
