

3. Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

Additionally, MPC has determined that it will not be feasible to complete construction of the proposed transmission line re-location project (Project) this fall during its previously scheduled outages. As such, MPC now plans to construct the Project in Second and/or Third Quarter of 2025 to align with a scheduled outage for safety purposes, and has discussed the updated timing with Commission Staff.
