**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

On September 11, 2024, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (MDU), an electric public utility, filed an application under North Dakota Century Code Chapter 49-03 to extend service to Applied Digital Corporation (Applied) at two locations in Dickey County, North Dakota.

Submitted with the application to serve Applied was a statement by Dakota Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. that they would not protest the application. Service is to be provided at points located in:

**The NE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 129 North, Range 63 West, Dickey County, North Dakota, and**


**The SE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 129 North, Range 63 West, Dickey County, North Dakota**

MDU has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer at both locations.

Any interested party has the right to file written objections, based on issues of public convenience and necessity, with the Commission by **November 8, 2024**, and the matters will then be set for hearings. If no objections are received by that date, the applications may be granted as requested.
