NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On September 5, 2024, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (MDU) filed an application for approval of an amendment to the electric service agreement the Commission approved on May 23, 2024, between Applied Digital Corporation d/b/a APLD-ELN-02 LLC (Applied) and MDU. The amendment modifies select provisions of that agreement in which Applied is taking service from MDU under MDU's High Density Contracted Demand Response Rate 45 schedule.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. What is the value of MDU's property, used and useful, for the service and convenience of the public in North Dakota?
2. What is a just and reasonable rate of return on MDU's property, used and useful, for the service and convenience of the public in North Dakota?
3. What rates and charges are necessary to provide a just and reasonable rate of return on MDU's property, used and useful, for the service and convenience of the public in North Dakota?
4. Are MDU's rate schedules designed in such a manner that they result in a basis of charge to its customers that is just and reasonable without undue discrimination?
5. Whether the amendment to the electric service agreement should be approved.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by December 3, 2024.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.
