NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On September 16, 2024, Otter Tail Power Company (OTP) filed an annual update under its Transmission Facility Cost Recovery Rider (TCRR) tariff. The proposed rate for 2025 includes the costs for six new transmission projects and updated costs for previously approved transmission projects. Furthermore, it also includes updated Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO) and Southwest Power Pool revenues and expenses and a true-up amount from the current rate. OTP also proposes to remove the wholesale revenue credit and instead include a true-up of MISO's Schedules 7, 8, and 9 from base rates. The decrease for a residential customer using 1,000 kWh per month would be \$0.96 per month. The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Whether the proposed rate adjustment complies with OTP's tariff,
2. Whether the incurred costs for new or modified electric transmission facilities and the proposed MISO true-up are reasonable and prudent, and
3. Whether the incurred costs are eligible for recovery through the TCRR.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by December 3, 2024.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
