If I do not receive a response by the date noted, I will determine whether there was a violation without your side of the story, based on the facts contained in these complaints. If I conclude a violation did occur, I will file with the Commission a formal complaint against Picard Excavating, Inc. which may result in a civil penalty up to \$25,000 per violation in accordance with North Dakota Century Code Section 49-07-01.1.

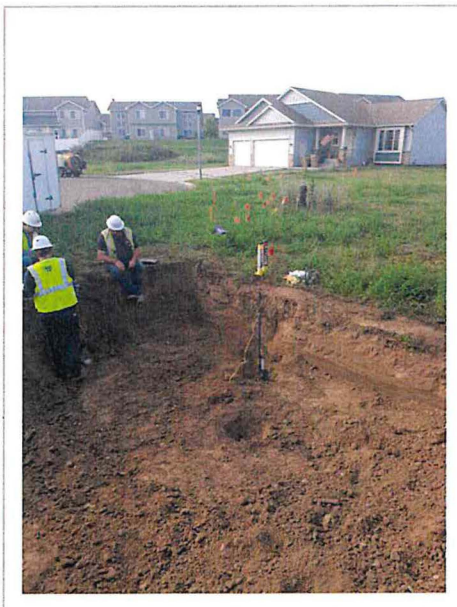

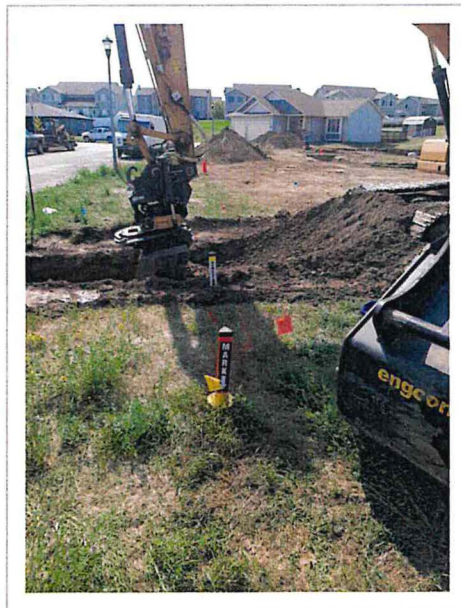

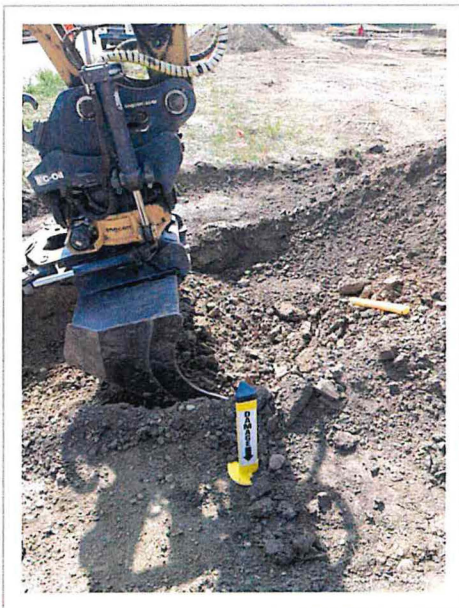
