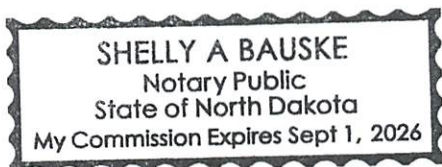

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

November 20, 2024

On October 31, 2024, Northern States Power Company (NSP) filed an application for revisions to its City Fee Rider tariff to incorporate the changes approved by the City of Grand Forks, North Dakota, eliminating a reduction in the franchise fee applicable to large users of electricity. There are currently no large volume customers in Grand Forks who qualify for the reduced City Fee.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Whether the proposed tariff changes are reasonable, and
2. Whether the tariff changes should be approved.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by January 6, 2025.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.


