On December 2, 2024, Northern States Power Company (NSP) filed an application to increase its Electric rates in North Dakota.

The primary drivers of the increase request as laid out by NSP are: Capital investments in electric generation, transmission and distribution systems, increased operation and maintenance expenses, and increased depreciation.
