NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On December 5, 2024, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (MDU) filed an application for approval for Amendment No. 3 Electric Service Agreement between Tesoro Refining & Marketing Company, LLC (Tesoro) and MDU. The amendment provides for continued sale of all firm electric power required by Tesoro at the same contract rates applicable to Tesoro today, as updated by the Commission in Case No. PU-22-194, MDU's most recent electric rate case.

The issue to be considered in this proceeding is whether the Amendment No. 3 Electric Service Agreement is just and reasonable and should be approved.


Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearings must be received by February 10, 2025.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.
