Comments:

We have notified Mor-Gran-Sou about this proposed project, they have not informed us of their intent to protest. There will be 2 services to 2 separate meter sockets that will be on the same meter structure but the service lines will be installed in a joint trench at this location. One for WBI Energy and the other for MDU. We are submitting two separate PC & N for this one project. While there are two separate entities WBI and MDU, these two meters are installed to provide power to the one common site which is the new Glen Ullin Town Border Station.
 MDU will be required to install 2~30 ft UG service lines and a riser up the pole.
 Mor-Gran-Sou would probably have to extend primary facilities to accommodate this request.
