

**WITHDRAWAL OF PROTESTS TO MDU’S APPLICATIONS FOR CERTIFICATES OF
PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY**

These matters came before the North Dakota Public Service Commission (Commission) on application of Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (MDU) to extend electric service to the Glen Ullin Town Border Station MDU and to Glen Ullin Town Border Station WBI at a site located in the NW1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 20, Township 139N, Range 88W, in Morton County, North Dakota. The applications for temporary authority were filed on December 17, 2024, and for permanent authority on January 15, 2025. Protests and requests for hearing were filed with the Commission by Mor-Gran-Sou Electric Cooperative, Inc. (MGS) on February 12, 2025.

Prior to hearing, the parties began settlement negotiations and on September 3, 2025, MGS and MDU entered into a Service Area Agreement to resolve and dispense of the matters now before the Commission.

Pursuant to the Service Area Agreement, MGS agreed that it would withdraw its protests to MDU's applications for permanent authority and certificates of public convenience and necessity.

NOW THEREFORE. Mor-Gran-Sou Electric hereby withdraws its protests dated February 12, 2025, filed in these matters and asks the Commission to approve the Service Area Agreement entered into by the parties and issue certificates of public convenience and necessity pursuant to MDU's applications for the same.


