To whom it may concern,

I will assure you that Anytime Hydroexcavation takes all one-calls very seriously and has not intentionally violated any laws. According to the complaint, it was said that we were working for Norther Valley Electric and their one call. We were working for Triangle Electric and had copied their approved one call. We were working on getting all four companies' approval on our one call because they had already approved the Triangle Electric one call. We had three of the four companies' approval and had left a message at Kinder Morgan. We arrived on location on the day of the said violation and shortly thereafter a Kinder Morgan employee showed up. He asked for our one call before any work had begun. He did not shut us down nor did he leave location while we worked for 6 Hours getting 75% to 80% of the job completed. Another Kinder Morgan employee showed up and shut us down saying they had not cleared us and we could not work off another company one call. I realize Kinder Morgan takes this very seriously as they should. They have billions of dollars of pipeline in the ground that they are protecting. We assumed we were cleared to work with the Kinder Morgan person on site. Again, this was prior to work beginning that day. Technically we were not clear to start work and have taken steps to ensure situations like this or any similar situations from happening in the future. I have attached a written timeline, the one call from us and Triangle Electric, our call logs, go-forms and a handwritten statement by our Operator. All these things should show that we honestly thought we were doing the right thing.

Timeline of Events

1/27/2025

JoAnn Robinson, Dispatcher for Anytime Hydro received a call from Kris Walcker from Triangle Electric to do a trenching job on the Continental Oil Hayes 6-7. Kris sent his approved one call ticket 25001511 (1). We used Triangle Electric's ticket to create a one call ticket for Anytime Hydro 25003156 (2). On 1/27/2025, JoAnn called all the companies on Anytime's one call ticket to get it cleared. Call log attached (3). All cleared except Kinder Morgan which she left a message.

1/28/2025

Copy of our Go-Form (4) showing on location arrival time at 9:00 AM on 1/28/2025. Statement from Anytime Operator, Scott Tasker (5) stating that a Kinder Morgan employee came to them prior to any work starting asked for Anytime's one call number. This employee watched them for over 6 hours completing 75 to 80% of the work. Around 3:00 PM, Ryan Farmer shows up and shuts us down saying Kinder Morgan had not cleared our one call. We stopped and while packing up they were marking the area. Call log for 1/28/2025 attached annotating the job shut down (6).

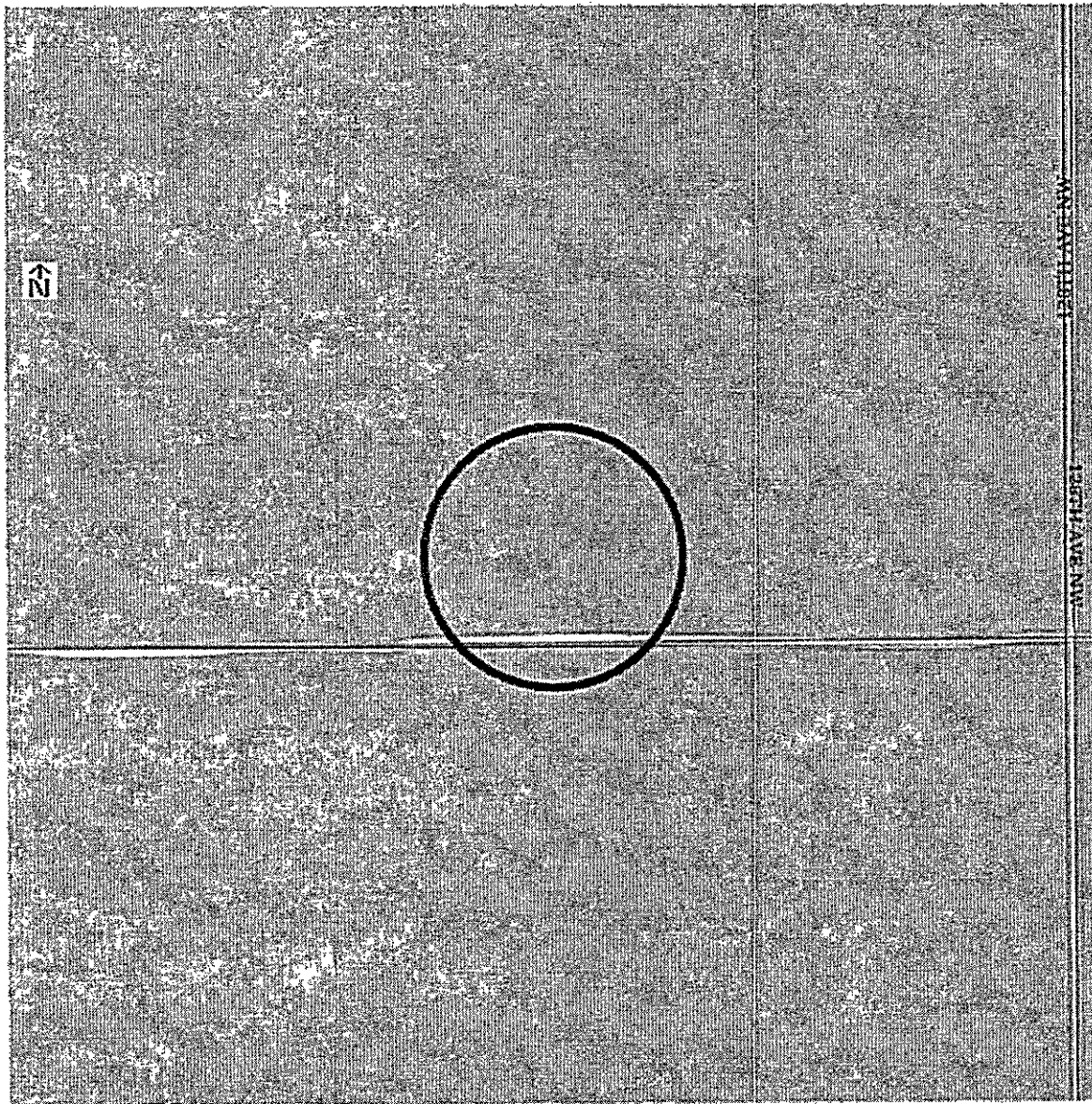

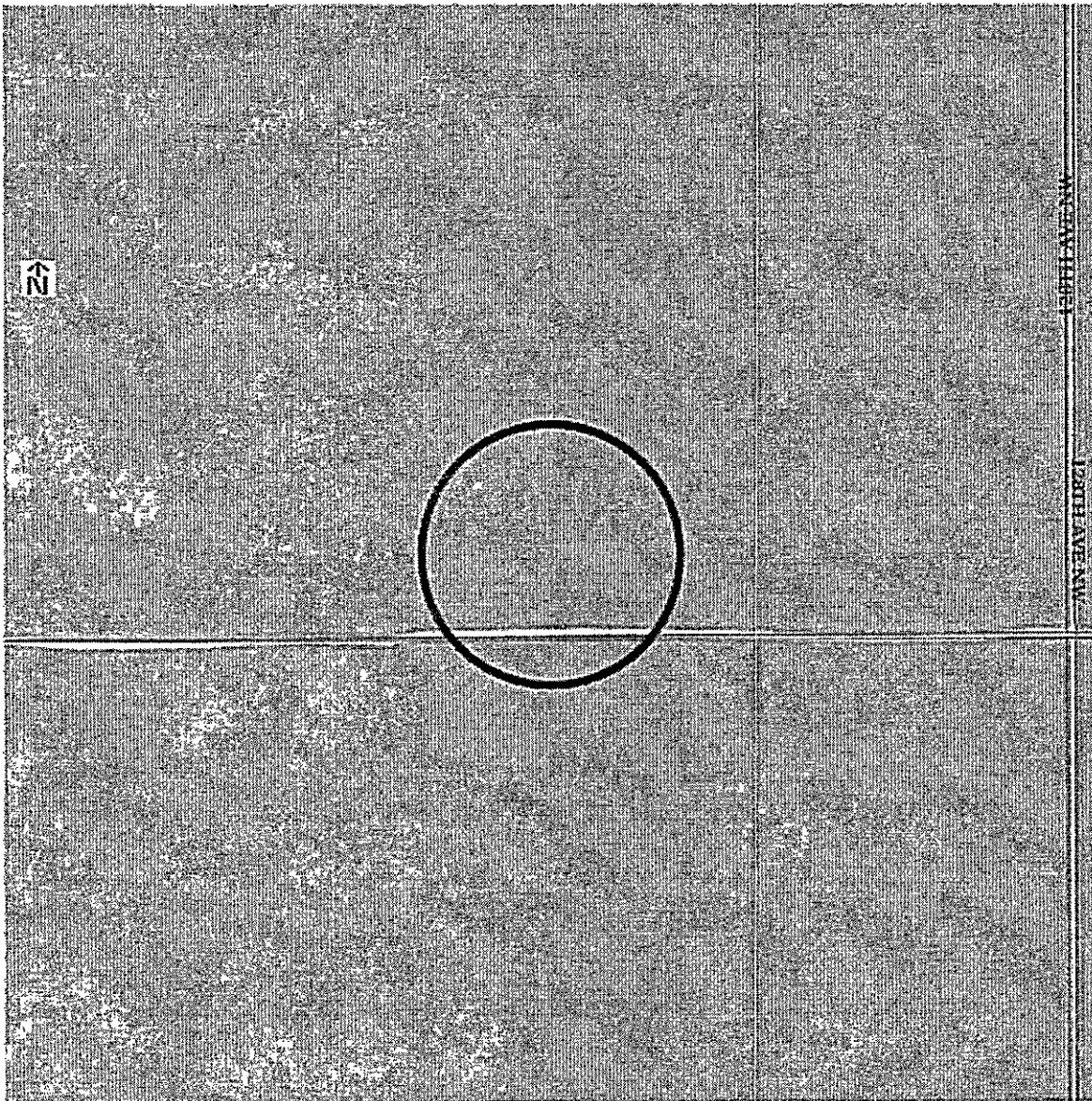

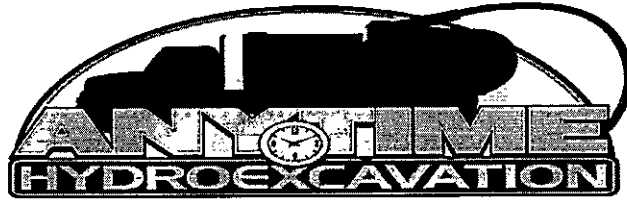

Your response and the North Dakota One-Call Complaint will be reviewed to determine whether there may be a violation of the One-Call Excavation Notice System law.

If I do not receive a response by the date noted, I will determine whether there was a violation without your side of the story, based on the facts contained in this complaint. If I conclude a violation did occur, I will file with the Commission a formal complaint against Anytime Hydroexcavation Inc. which may result in a civil penalty up to \$25,000 per violation in accordance with North Dakota Century Code Section 49-07-01.1.
