In response to the One-Call Complaint from last year on 3/17/25, I had set up a meeting with Kinder Morgan Locaters. They showed up with two guys in the pickup at the location where we were close to the pipeline. The passenger in the Kinder Morgan pickup followed me to the dig site which was probably 75 feet from where they parked, we measured everything out making sure we were at least 25 feet from the gas line which had been located by these guys. I asked him if he approved of our dig area and said everything looked good. After 30-40 minutes the driver exited the pickup and came to where we were working and told us he was going to turn us in for not having a locate in which I did but I was off from where we were actually digging but not far enough that it was not obvious where the lathes were headed. This well site had been recently built, none of the roads or wells showed up on the one call ap so i did the best I could to cover our working area. It was a staked route with lathe, I know the locater that wouldn't get out of the pickup was new to his job, but sometimes a little common sense goes a long way.
