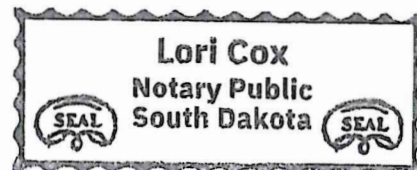

Please take notice that BNI Coal Ltd., 2360 35th Avenue SW, Center, North Dakota 58530-9499 has submitted applications to the North Dakota Public Service Commission for Permit Renewal No. 5 and Revision No. 45 to BNCR-9702, approved on August 2, 2000, to engage in surface coal mining and reclamation operations. The area for which a permit renewal is sought includes approximately 7,655 acres in parts of Sections 20, 21, 27, 28, 29, 31, 32, 33 and

34 T142N R84W and parts of Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 T141N R84W. This area is in Oliver County, North Dakota and is shown on the accompanying map.
