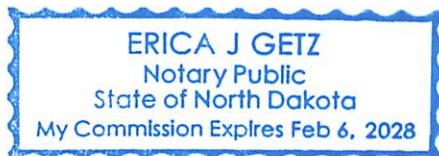


**NOTICE OF FILING AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

A **Public Hearing** on the application in Case No. PU-25-172 is scheduled for **July 30, 2025, at 9 a.m. Central Time at Nessel Consulting Service, 6844 State Hwy 40, Tioga, ND 58852.**

On April 28, 2025, ONEOK Bakken Pipeline, L.L.C. (ONEOK) filed an application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and route permit for a 7.6-mile-long, 6-inch steel natural gas pipeline located in Williams County. The pipeline location is shown on the attached map.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Will the location and operation of the proposed facility produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Is the proposed facility compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility location minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
